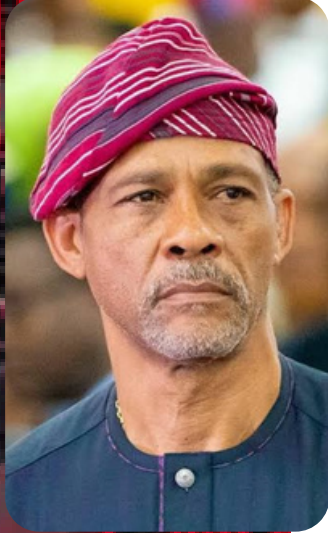

However, the use of AI in biosecurity also raises governance challenges, including data privacy, ethics, and digital inequality. Addressing these concerns is essential to ensure equitable benefits across Africa.

The 10th Annual GET Conference was a landmark event, attracting over 3,000 delegates. Held in a hybrid format, the conference reached a global audience and received overwhelmingly positive feedback from participants, sponsors, and exhibitors. The conference provided an excellent platform for networking and knowledge exchange, with attendees praising the quality of the sessions and the impactful discussions. 

The Global Emerging Pathogens Treatment Consortium (GET) was established in 2014 as a direct response to the 2014-2016 Ebola virus disease outbreak in West Africa and ongoing outbreaks of Lassa Fever, Meningitis, Multidrug resistance (MDR) enteric fever and Yellow Fever across the sub-region. There was clearly a need to create an African-led multidisciplinary forum of experts capable of working together with international partners to strengthen Africa's preparedness and resilience in tackling such infectious disease outbreaks caused by emerging pathogens, public health emergencies and pandemics. GET now operates firmly in the African Biosecurity space and functions as a think tank. Providing high-level advocacy and operational and necessary expertise to support countries and communities to achieve improved resources to combat outbreaks and other public health emergencies that can threaten stability, peace and security thereby undermining economic growth and wellbeing. GET is legally registered in Lagos, Nigeria, Accra, Ghana, Sierra Leone, and the [www.getafrica.org](http://www.getafrica.org). Our primary purpose is to develop African-led and Afrocentric strategies within an international context to effectively address emerging infectious diseases. 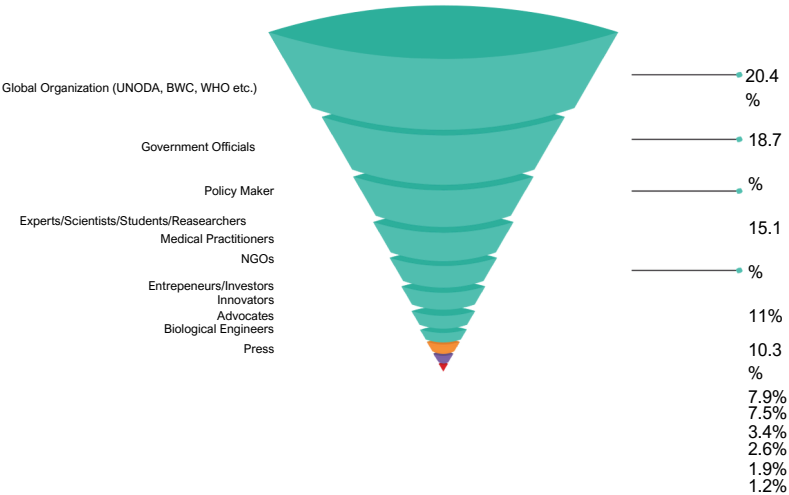
